NATIVE HEDGEROW PLANTING AT GREENHAM HOUSE GARDENS

The Town Council’s Green Spaces Working Group, together with local volunteers, successfully planted a native hedgerow at Greenham House Gardens on 27 January.

Cllr Gary Norman, Leader of the Council said, “We were pleased that a number of residents came along to help plant the native hedgerow and take part in this community event. This follows our wildflower seeding that took place at Greenham House Gardens in the autumn in 2023. Newbury Town Council are sponsoring this event for the Community to enjoy in the future.”
