If you are involved with an organisation or charity that benefits the residents of Newbury, don't miss your chance to apply for grant funding for a special project or core costs.

To apply you must register with The Good Exchange <https://thegoodexchange.com> and complete the grant application process between 1 June 2018 and 21 October 2018. All applications for funding that are on the Good Exchange website by this date, which fulfil the Town Council's criteria, will be considered. Applicants may be invited to give a short presentation of their application at a meeting of the Grant Sub-Committee on 21 November 2018.

The Council will be looking for suitable beneficiaries for the balance of the grant funds for the current year, which total £11,250, of which £4,500 is specifically for projects involving young people. The Good Exchange had kindly agreed to match fund all the grants, making the total available £22,500.
