Town Council Sets Up Coronavirus Emergency Fund

Newbury Town Council has allocated £8,000 from its grant fund to assist projects and proposals helping the elderly, vulnerable and at-risk communities in Newbury in response to the coronavirus crisis.

Cllr Gary Norman, Chairperson of the Council's Grants Subcommittee, explained that the Council took this move in order to assist charities and other organisations who need funding to respond to the emergency.

"The Council has made the grant available through The Good Exchange online fundraising platform and funder Greenham Trust has agreed to match fund the amount, doubling the value of our funds and facilitating an even greater contribution to the fantastic work being undertaken by organisations supporting those impacted by the coronavirus in our community."
