All entries must stick to the following criteria:

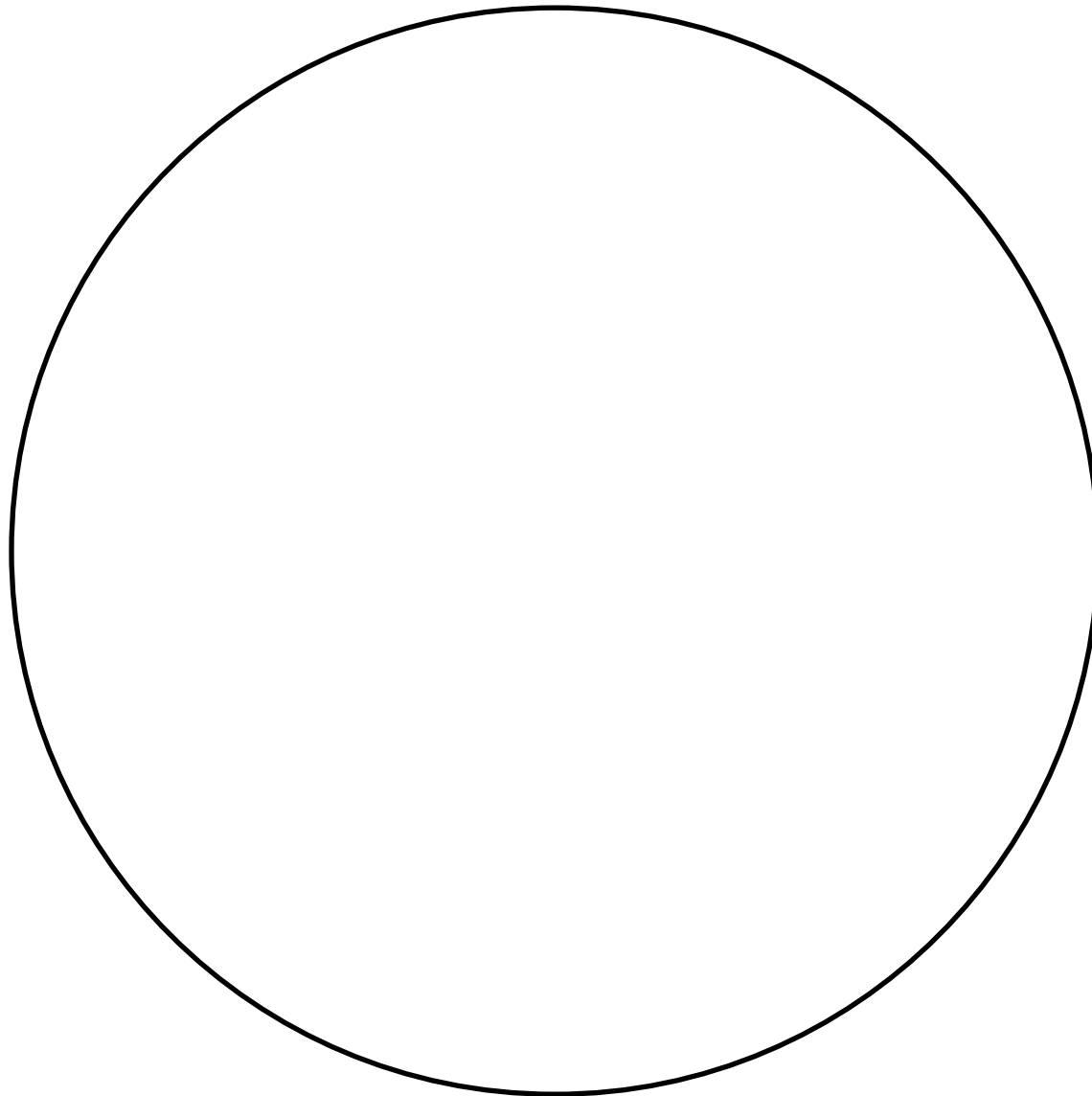
- The design will need to fit into a 25mmx25mm circle. Please the space provided to submit your design.
- **A maximum of FOUR colours can be used.**
- Words and images can be used, as long as they are eligible.
- Original artwork only must be submitted, no copy rights or stock images to be used.
- Your design must celebrate the community spirit of Newbury.
- The winning design will give Newbury Town Council permission to reproduce the winning design to be manufactured and used as part of the Civic Awards scheme for 2021's Community Champion award, to be given to all award winners in this special one-off category.

All ages are welcome to submit an entry.

The deadline for all entry submissions is **Sunday 17th January 2020.**

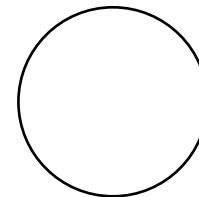
